OIS MISSION: We are dedicated to fulfilling every child's educational and developmental needs in a safe and caring environment conducive to learning and teaching. We aim to create responsible, global citizens who show understanding, compassion and acceptance of the differences in the world. We strive to ensure that every child in our care is empowered to make choices and encouraged to contribute to our community.

THE SCHOOL: OIS was founded in August 2008 and is a private, co-educational day school offering education to students from Playschool till Grade 12. The current enrollment of over 1400 students includes 255 students in Grade 9 through 12. The student body represents 35 nationalities. The school's first graduating class was in 2011. The language of instruction is English. The school year consists of two semesters, starting in August and ending in June with 183 student-teacher contact days.

OIS is authorized by the **IBO** as an International Baccalaureate World School, and is fully accredited by **CIS** and **NEASC**. It is also a member of **EARCOS**.

THE CURRICULUM: The school provides an international curriculum which all students must follow.

The **IB Diploma Program** is a rigorous curriculum for the 11th and 12th grades, requiring the student to study six subjects within the academic groups of Studies in Language and Literature, Language Acquisition, Individuals & Societies, Sciences, Mathematics and the Arts. In addition to this students must complete the elements of the Core including the Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course; a 4000 word Extended Essay and activities / projects in the areas of Creativity, Action and Service (CAS). www.ibo.org/diploma

CLASS RANK: The school does not rank students nor takes GPA into account.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES: In addition to a strong academic curriculum, the school encourages involvement and engagement beyond the classroom. The school provides a competitive Athletic program, student clubs, as well as a formal after-school activities program. Some of the clubs offered by the school include Model United Nations, Habitat for Humanity and Operation Smile. Sports include badminton, basketball, gymnastics, football, tennis, squash and swimming. Students also volunteer for various social causes through the school such as Teach for India, Udaan Foundation, Indian Cancer Society, and many others.
